Please take note of the below eligibility criteria and guidance before completing the form.

### Eligibility Criteria & Expression of Interest Guidance

Egmont offers new Partners funding for an Innovation Project. An Innovation Project lasts one-year and is supported with a grant of **up to \$20,000**.

Egmont funds non-governmental organisations registered and operating in **Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Tanzania, Zambia & Zimbabwe**. Egmont **does not fund** projects taking place outside these countries.

Egmont works directly with local organisations and **does not accept** applications from international organisations submitting on behalf of local partners.

**Please note that we do not fund** capital projects such as infrastructure development and building construction.

Beyond this, Egmont is not prescriptive in the types of activities we fund.

Egmont has funded many varied projects, all conceived and delivered by our Egmont Partners. We know that the most effective responses are those that are developed within the communities they seek to help and are open to any approach that achieves and can evidence impact. **It is up to you to demonstrate the validity of your approach and the effectiveness of your activities to date.**

You should **briefly outline** what your organisation has already achieved and how Egmont funding will enable you to scale up your activities, reach and impact.

Once you have submitted your Expression of Interest, Egmont will contact you if you have been successful. This process should take 4 - 6 months. **We are not able to contact every organisation that is unsuccessful at this stage.**

If you do not hear from Egmont after submitting your Expression of Interest, please do not submit another Expression of Interest for at least 12 months.
